Science

Here in Loreto Foxrock, we have five state of the art science laboratories and teachers are supported behind the scenes by our experienced lab technician.

Students are encouraged to take part in extra-curricular activities in science such as the BT Young Scientist & Technology Exhibition and activities during Science Week. Students of science learn through scientific inquiry, enabling them develop their knowledge of science by applying the scientific method. They are encouraged to interpret and analyse scientific evidence and data to draw their own conclusions while developing an understanding of the world around them.

This prepares them for their studies in Leaving Cert Physics, Chemistry and Biology, all of which are offered in Loreto Foxrock.

Science Club

In Science Club, we aim to foster a passion for science and learning in students; to encourage students to never stop questioning; to help students to find out about the world we live in and why things happen the way they do.

Science Club is run every week during lunchtime for First Year students. All participants get the opportunity to complete exciting experiments like creating a giant bubble; making their hair stand on end using static electricity; or having fun on the hovercraft.

Students also get the chance to carry out experiments that would not normally be included in the syllabus. In this way, they experience a fun and exciting side of science that they may not otherwise encounter.
