## **Mission Statement**



# Academic Results & Awards since 2018

#### **2024 Leaving Certificate –**

600+ 16% of students (3 with 625), 550+ 32% of students, 500+ 58% of students, 450+ 74% of students, 400+ 89% of students

- •We were especially proud of our students who would have experienced difficulty in their learning due to a SEN, health or life circumstances. They all achieved to their potential.
- •In 2023 15 students were awarded the Entrance Scholars Award to UCD, and 2 students received an Entrance Scholarship to TCD.
- •Our teacher Dr Young has been awarded Physics Teacher of the Year by the Institute of Physics in London.
